MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP

Dearly Beloved in Christ,

The March issue of the *Besorah* will be reaching you while I am still out of the United States. I will be returning on March 12, after attending the Maramon Convention, the Sabha Council, the Episcopal Synod, and after visiting some of our parishes and missions in India and in Europe.

The 117th Maramon Convention was from February 12-19, 2012. The main speakers for the convention included Bishop Malusi Mpumlwana from South Africa, Rev. Martin Alphonse from the U.S. and Rev. Kang-San-Tan from Malaysia. The theme of the Convention was “Arise, let us be going” Mt. 26:46. You can view and listen to the convention speeches at <http://video.mtconvention.com>.

The convention theme challenges us to ponder critically about where we should arise from, and where we should go to. The answer, I believe, is to arise from our inertia and go into action. What kind of action should we spring into? First, we should arise to pray and intercede for others, while also carefully listening to what God has to say to us. Secondly, we should arise to fight the desires of the flesh. Thirdly, we should arise to bear the pain of others. This is what Jesus exemplified to His disciples when He invited them to, “Arise” and go along with Him. Please also read Mt. 16:24.

We see how Jesus studied the scriptures, quoted from it and applied it in His life. If we desire to be faithful followers of Jesus, we should also have a special place for the scripture to enhance our spiritual life. During this Lenten season, let us arise and spring into action while firmly rooted in the Word of God.

PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL CENTERS WITHIN THE DIOCESE



Through the initiative of Mar Theodosius, the advice of the Council and its Planning Board, and the leadership of the clergy and lay people in various regions within the diocese, progress is being made towards the development of regional centers within the diocese. The proposed eight centers will include a Christian Education Forum in the Northeast Region, a Center for Family Ministry in the Southeast Region, a Family Assisted Living Center in the Southern Region, a Counseling Center in the Southwest Region, a Development Center in the Western Region, a Legal Cell in the Midwest Region, a Counseling Center in the Canada Region, and a Mission Center in the Europe Region.

Currently, discussions are going on within the respective regions to develop specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, and timely goals for each of the proposed centers.
